\$990 grant continues

THE deadline for a \$990 government grant for an equity capital raising program has been extended.

Due to close last Monday, it has been extended to September 14.

The program, Stepping up Preparation for an Equity Capital Raising, is aimed at NSW-based small and medium-sized enterprises that are high growth and in need of expansion capital.

It is presented by the Alchemy Innovation Development, in association with the NSW Department of Industry and Investment.

The program looks at the assistance and resources required to mount a private equity capital raising through the Australian Small Scale Offers Board, which specialises in helping unlisted, high-growth companies get capital for seed, expansion or special projects.
